Study Objectives:

To establish a **safe, accessible, and efficient transportation system.**

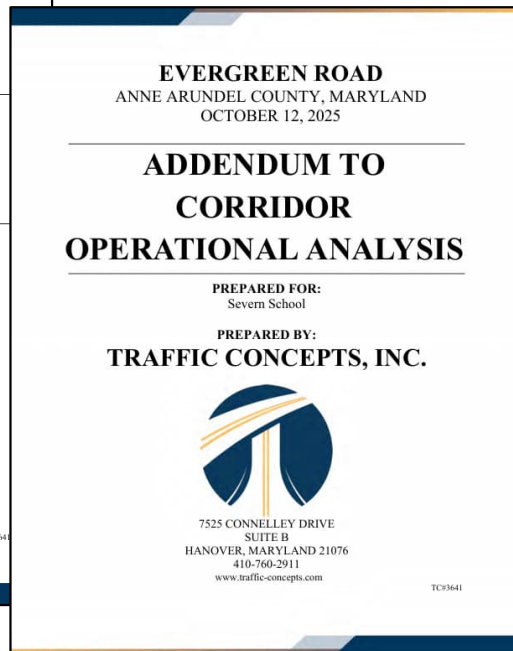
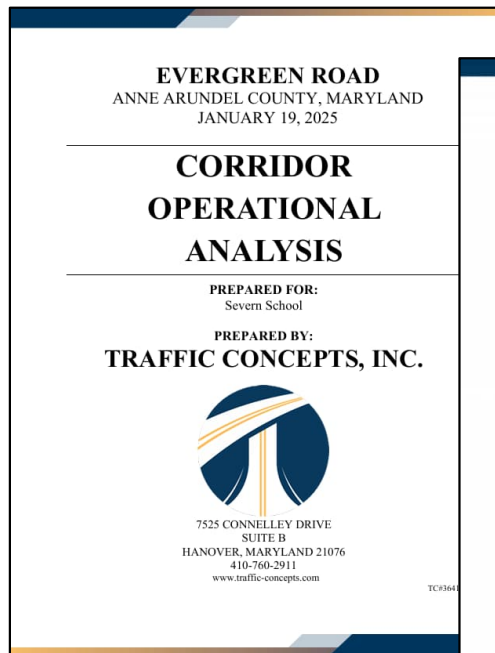
- Address traffic operational / mobility concerns
- Address safety concerns for all road users
- Improve pedestrian/bicycle access at the B&A Trail crossings & throughout the study area
- Confirm a preferred set of measures to move forward into a future capital project.

Key Issues:

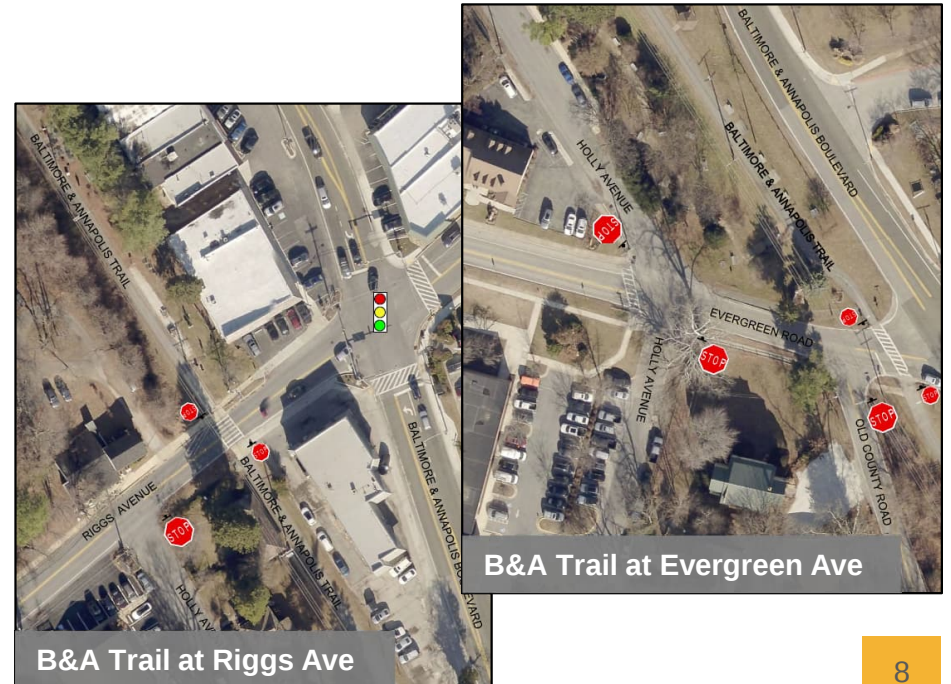
- **Long-standing concerns**
 - Riggs Ave at Evergreen Rd / Maple Ave → high conflict area
 - MD 648 (B&A Trail) at Evergreen Rd → morning peak queues
 - Holly Ave at Evergreen Rd → sight distance concerns
- **B&A Trail crossings → pedestrian and bicycle safety concerns**
- **School congestion concerns**
 - Severna Park Elementary School queues → spill back onto Riggs Ave
 - Queue durations: 20-30 minutes
 - School start/end times → Elementary School (8AM – 2:25PM)
→ Severn School (8AM – 3PM)

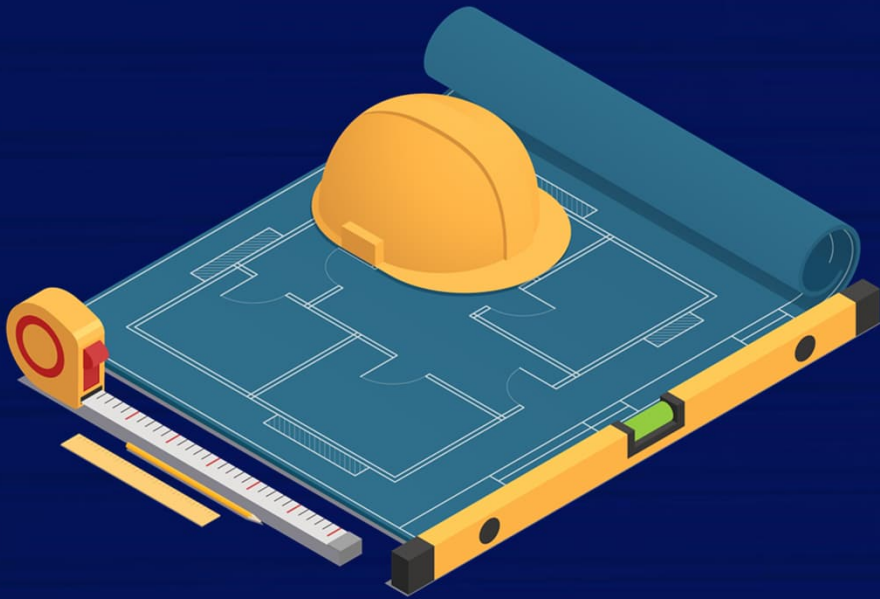
