 - Focused on Blueprint pillar 4. Working on getting workgroups started and working with MHA in Consortium program
 - Strategic plan priority 4 is current focus
 - Belle Grove Vision to Learn event to get glasses to students who need them. Borrowing van from Balt. County but looking for partners to help purchase a van for AA County (cost is \$500k)
 - New telehealth center opens in October
 - Concentration of poverty dollars are being spent in community through partnerships with community members/organizations
