- 1. The meeting of the Disability Retirement Pension Review Board for the Police Service Retirement Plan ("Board") was called to order at approximately 12:30 p.m.
- 2. All attendees were introduced.
- 3. The purpose of the meeting was announced. The purpose of the meeting is to consider the request of a member of the Police Service Retirement Plan to review and evaluate the decision of the Personnel Officer denying their request for a service-connected disability retirement and their request for a non-service-connected disability retirement.
- 4. The requirements of the Open Meetings Act were discussed.
- 5. Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §3-305, a Motion to Close the session to the public to discuss a personnel matter regarding a member of the Police Service Retirement Plan and to protect the privacy of a member of the Police Service Retirement Plan with respect to a matter that is not related to public business was made by Dr. Chilaka and seconded by Ms. McLaughlin. The Board directed the Chair to take certain actions.
